Margaret Dickinson is a graduate of Oberlin Conservatory of Music and the Ohio State University, where she also served on the music faculty. She was a two-year Fulbright Scholar in Frankfurt, Germany, where she met and later married Fellow scholar Melvin Dickinson. Together they formed the Louisville Bach Society in 1964. Calvary served as the LBS home for many of the ensuing years. Margaret taught organ, church service playing, and harpsichord literature at the University of Louisville 1964-2000. Margaret was director of music, outreach and communications at Calvary 1964-2012, and at present is the coordinator of Calvary's very active food ministry to feed the poor in our neighborhood. 9,806 people have been fed through this program since March 16, 2020. Her Lenten recital in 2021 will feature patriotic works by Reger, Paine, and Buck.
